Stretching for 13 miles (21 km) from San Pedro de Alcántara to the east of the town of Estepona along the Costa del Sol, the new Golden Mile is yours to explore.





## THE PATH TO FREEDOM

Bike trails along a glittering coastline

The bespoke New Golden Mile Experience at Ikos Andalusia takes you on a beautiful 8.4 KM route (5.2 miles), offering an easy, picturesque beachfront bike trail for various levels of skill and fitness.

Mid-tour, you'll make a stop in a picturesque location for a short rest and recharge, with light refreshments as you take in the view.

Duration: 1h 30 mins one-way (avg. speed)



### CHARMING CORNERS



The old town of Estepona is one of the most beautiful in Andalusia, and is famed for its traditional charm. Also known as the "The Garden of the Costa del Sol", Estepona boasts quiet squares, white houses, and streets decorated with overflowing flowerpots. Follow this route to discover the most beautiful and charming corners of the city.

### THE POETRY ROUTE



The streets of the historic centre are lined with famous poems from across the world. Take a stroll through the old town and enjoy the art form in many languages, as well as art, sculptures and murals by famed international artists which adorn the area.



### ROUTE OF THE MURALS

Known for rich artistic culture & history, Estepona is home to well known street art by artists of national and international importance. Take the Murals Route and meander through the town as you spot the oversized works of art decorating the sides of buildings.

### YOUR IKOS GUIDE

The Golden Mile Experience can be enjoyed on a bike as a solo session or with the whole family, while hiking tours are available as a guided activity.

### DEPARTURE POINT

The New Golden Mile Experience begins at the Ikos Andalusia Bike Centre, simply arrive ten minutes before your scheduled booking. In the event of any changes to your meeting point, this will be shared with you upon arrival at the resort.

### WHO CAN JOIN

The Golden Mile Experience is subject to limitations. Child seats are provided for children under 8, and all children must be accompanied by an adult.

### WHAT TO BRING

We advise guests to bring sunscreen, water and insect repellent for all outdoor activities.

### WHAT TO WEAR

We recommend appropriate athletic clothing for this activity, suitable for outdoor activities. Sturdy, close-toed footwear suitable for sports and a hat or cap is also advised for hiking tours, while helmets are compulsory for bike tours and are provided.
